

The DOVES Program Applicant Eligibility Requirements

To be eligible to work at the DOVES Program, applicants must be able to successfully pass the following background checks. These checks will be conducted for all states the applicant has lived in, worked in or gone to school in during the last 2-5 years (depending on position).

- Criminal Background
- Child Protection & Safety (CPS) | Adult Protection & Safety (APS)
- Sex Offender Registry

To be eligible to drive for the DOVES Program, which is a required work task, the applicant must meet the following requirements:

- No major violations, including DUI, Racing, Hit & Run, Speeding in excess of 20mph or Manslaughter within the past 5 years.
- No more than 2 moving violations within the past 3 years.
- No more than 1 at fault accident within the past 3 years.

Applicants must be able to work the schedule stated on the job description.
